Executes the review and coordination of all activities pertaining to Access to Information requests to protect Pfizer's confidential/proprietary information according to the provisions of the Access to Information Act.

#### **Business Alignment**

Provides support across Business Units (X-BU) and to other Pfizer functions as Subject Matter Expert (SME) for regulatory/legal matters (Patents & Data Protection, ATIs). In addition, contribute to overall departmental effectiveness by leading or participating in various assigned projects.
